Such as: "Mainzer Allgemeine Zeitung", "Kökner Stadtanzeiger", "Express", "Bild-Zeitung", "NEUE REVUE", "Quick", "Bunte". Presently I represent the "BURDA" Publishing Company, Bild + Funk, Wiesbaden as regional chiefeditor. Before matriculating and studying Journalism, I was brought up in catholic tradition, which - although disciple of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh - I still practice and with which - for the high moral virtues indicated terein, I deal with high respect.
