I have been working for 5 years as a co-ordinator in a social welfare institute in LORRACH, West Germany. The main part of the work was prevention, therapy and rehabilitation of adolescent drug addicts. There are two articles published in scientific papers about my work.

The therapy of drug addicts includes an immense need of well-skilled therapists, finances and organisat. The success rate is tiny. Mostly after a short period of time the therapists feel helpless.
