To whom it may concern,

I write to you as a biologist. I got a degree and a PhD in biology at the Universities of Lausanne and Geneva in Switzerland. In 1970, I had the chance to work with Konrad Lorenz, a Nobel Prize in Medicine, in his favorite field which is ethology. The next year, I worked under the guidance of Professor Bouey who is also a Nobel Prize in Medicine. Between 1972 and 1980 I worked in different universities (PIJA - GENEVA - LAUSANNE) where I specialized in endocrinology.

In 1976, I went to India where I met personally the spiritual Master Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh spending six months in his community. Something deep changed in my life that has been verified when I started working again. I discovered new ways of researching, less attached to the traditional scientific ideas and more open to totally new concepts.

Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh used to talk frequently about the value of medical research. His respect for the human body is infinite because

he considered it as the temple of God understood what he was saying, I got a real trust in the value of my research. In Rajneeshpuram you can see everywhere how this aspect of his religious teaching is realized. Healthy people live there and they are supported by a very good medical center. The physical presence of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh is however needed to develop the community in the sense of his true teaching. Having been in his silent presence during the two last july festivals, I felt an incredible joy and love spreading from him into all the community. The quality of life around Bhagwan has the quality of celebration. Working or dancing, it is all a celebration. And this can happen only because he is here.

Considering these points of view, Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh is a person of exceptional ability in Arts and Sciences as well as the greatest spiritual master of any time. His presence in America is an incredible gift and opportunity for this country. I hope you will take this letter into consideration as far as the application of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh's visa is concerned.
