Because of the application for Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh visa to stay in the USA, I write this letter to tell you what a richness it is to have Bhagwan in this country.

First I shall introduce myself.

My sanyas name is Kandha, and Cecilia van de Boom. I live in Holland, I've university degrees in social work, and I was practising my job for 7 years in Holland, I worked with groups of neurotic people. I worked with teenagers and later on with criminals.

Seven years ago I came across Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh, while traveling through India. I met him in Poona in one of his discourses.

It happened to be that he talked about neuroses and humanity in such a way that my heart was very touched. Again and again I went to his discourses and a new vision arose in me. The very simple way he explained things made me look differently at life.

Also the ashram in Poona was full of healthy young, dynamic people. And suddenly I saw in reality, what I was studying all these years. Here nobody was studying but living life as simple as it is.

I stayed 5 years in this ashram and learned to live my own life in a very simple way. Never had I found myself with as few problems as at this time.


Now I'm visiting Rajneeshpuram and I'm doing a meditation programme.
